

## Recording and Publication Policy -- APPROVED

It is our policy for all future content:

- That all session audio and computer presentation video (images and content presented on screen by presenters) may be recorded by NAATW at any of our event sessions, including Birds of a Feather sessions. Presenters grant NAATW the right to use and reproduce these sessions, while also maintaining their own right to do the same.
- That anyone speaking as a general audience member also grants NAATW the right to publish this content.
- To maintain AA's tradition of anonymity NAATW will not publish anyone's last name or face.
- That the recent Workshop content will be available as soon as technically possible to Workshop attendees on our website behind a login.
- That after a short period of time as determined by the Steering Committee and not to exceed 6 months, we will publish this content for public viewing, not behind a login.
- That we will either self-record or pay tapers for their services only, in order that we maintain the rights to re-publish the content per this policy.
- That content downloads will be permitted along with online viewing. We will make clear that the download content is only for personal usage and may not be re-posted online.

It is our policy for all past content:

- That NAATW already has the right to publish the 2019 audio content, as announcements were made at the beginning of every session.
- That NAATW has a desire to use an abundance of caution where explicit permission has not been given, thus, we will only publish audio content from before 2019 with the permission of the presenter.
- That while NAATW has the video presentation output for 2019, recording of such content was an experiment, and thus, we will only publish the video content from 2019 with the permission of the presenter.
