


Responsive Websites WHY?

WHY? More mobile devices.




Why? More time spent on Mobile.

Internet Usage (Engagement) Growth Solid +11% Y/Y = Mobile @ 3 Hours / Day per User vs. <1 Five Years Ago, USA



Why? Vertical Screen Use Growing



time spent with each medium includes all time spent with that medium, regardless of multitasking; for example, 1 hour of multitasking on desktop/laptop while waithing TV is counted as 1 hour for TV and 1 hour for desktop/laptop.

Mhàs

- ▶ More than 20 percent of Google searches are now being performed on some sort of mobile device.
- In 2012, over half of all <u>local</u> searches were done on a mobile device.
- ▶ 25 percent of Internet users only access the internet via a mobile device in the United States.
- 77% of mobile searches occur at home or at work even if a PC is nearby and readily available

Mhàs

- ▶ Google Search
- ▶ Starting April, 2015, Mobile Friendliness became a search criterion.
 - ▶ For Searches from Mobile Devices.
 - ▶ Does not affect searches from desktops & laptops.

Responsive Websites WHAT?

What? -- Mobile Friendly Sites

Three ways to implement a mobile friendly website:

- 1. Separate URL's -- e.g. <u>www.xyz.com</u> and <u>m.xyz.com</u>.
- 2. Dynamic serving
- 3. Responsive web design

What? – Responsive Web Design

Responsive Web Design

- ▶ Serves the same HTML code on the same URL regardless of the users' device (desktop, tablet, mobile), but can render the display differently (i.e., "respond") based on the screen size.
- Accomplished using new facilities in html5 and css3.
- Responsive design is Google's recommended design pattern.

Responsive Websites HOW?

Hows

- ► Three ways to create a responsive website:
- 1. From Scratch using html5 and css3. (the hard way.)
- 2. Use an automated conversion service.
- 3. Use a responsive template.

How? - Mobile Conversion Service

- ► Many choices.
- Methods and prices vary widely.
 - ▶\$10 per month to \$100 per page.
- ▶ Active Pages, Forms, and JavaScript can be problematic.
- Perhaps a good choice for simple text & table based sites.

How? - Mobile Conversion Service

How? – Use Responsive Template

- Many templates available at reasonable cost.
- ► Templates available for many development platforms
 - ▶ WordPress, Drupal, Joomla, Dreamweaver, etc.
- ▶ For most pages, it's just cut and paste from the old pages into a new responsive page.
- Forms and Tables may need to be reworked

How? – Our Experience

- Used Dreamweaver Template from justdreamweaver.com.
- ▶ For most pages the conversion was trivial.
- Were able to use images from the old site.
- ▶ Putting our menu on the new site was easy.
- ► Forms needed to be redesigned.
- Some tables needed adjustment.
- Google maps converted nicely.
