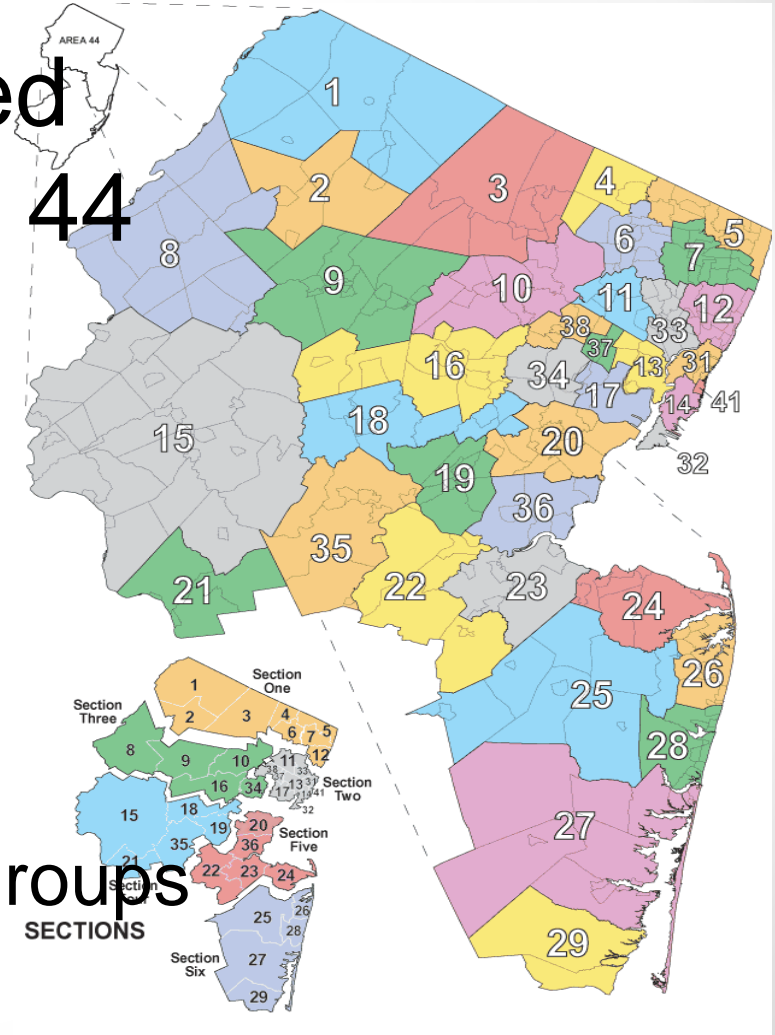

Usage of MS Office 365 at Northern NJ AA Area 44

- Office 365 implemented January 2019 for Area 44
- Intended for:
 - Area 44 Officers
 - 7 Standing Committees
 - 13 Special Committees
 - 35 Districts
 - GSRs from >1100 area groups
- 600+ IDs assigned



Primary Uses of MS Office 365 at NJ AA Area 44

- **Outlook** for email and calendar events
- **SharePoint** for document storage and sharing
- **Teams** for video conferencing and collaboration
- **Office Apps** for creating and editing documents

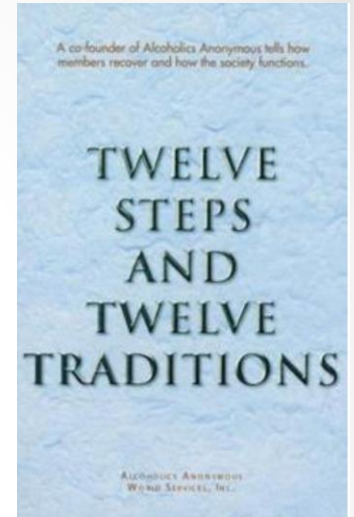
Benefits for Using Outlook at NJ Area 44

- Role-based IDs instead of personal email accounts to maintain anonymity
- AA service members based on display name rather than name (e.g. Area Chair vs Joe S)
- Push calendar events for committee and district events, with online meeting links
- Send emails to all **Share44** users or to specific committees or districts by use of distribution lists and email directory
- Emails retained after rotation

Benefits for Using SharePoint at NJ Area 44

- Documents stored on SharePoint servers instead of personal devices
- IDs assigned to security groups for access rights to document subsites
- Documents can be shared to specific groups or with all **Share44** users
- Files and information maintained after rotation
- Online forms (e.g., Assembly registration)

Share44 and the AA Traditions



- How MS Office 365 is used in accordance with:
 - **Tradition 5:** Carrying the message
 - **Tradition 6:** Never endorsing an outside enterprise
 - **Tradition 7:** Declining outside contributions
 - **Tradition 12:** Maintaining personal anonymity

Share44 and Tradition 5

Carry the message to the alcoholic who still suffers

- **Share44** is used to help Area 44 service members carry the message
- Tools to help service members carry the message include:
 - Email communication and calendar events
 - Document storage and sharing for flyers, minutes, budgets, and guidelines
 - Video conferencing and collaboration
 - IDs for Bridging the Gap

Share44 and Tradition 6

Never endorse or lend the AA name to any outside enterprise

- ***Share44*** domain changed from OnMicrosoft.com to NJArea44.Org
- System is named ***Share44*** instead of MS Office 365
- External links provided only to AA sites
- AA uses several technology tools such as Microsoft, Google, Facebook, and Zoom without implying endorsements

Share44 and Tradition 7

Fully self-supporting, declining outside contributions

- Area 44 RUS Corporation is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization
- MS Office 365 Enterprise E1 Plan is provided free to non-profit organizations
 - Must provide IRS non-profit documents
 - Must renew license annually
 - At least 85% of assigned IDs must use the system within the past 90 days

Share44 and Tradition 12

Anonymity is the spiritual foundation of all Traditions

- **Share44** does not include any Personal Identifiable Information (PII) in user profiles
- Role-based IDs used instead of personal email IDs to maintain anonymity
- Confidential account file with names and personal contact information is accessible only to C&T committee members
- Automatic email forwarding to personal email accounts is blocked
- Emails sent with **Share44** IDs used to contact corrections and treatment prospective AA members

Challenges With *Share44*

- Users:
 - Want to use their personal email accounts
 - Cannot remember their IDs and passwords
 - Do not like Teams compared to Zoom
 - Do not read help documents sent with IDs
 - Not familiar with shared document systems
 - Email cleanup following rotation
- Service members have multiple service roles, which complicates role-based IDs/display names
- Training and support take resources and time
- Microsoft requires 85% usage for past 90 days

Share44 Usage by Area 44 Service Members

Group	#IDs	%Active
Area Officers and Delegates	10	100%
Area Standing and Special Committee Chairs/Co-Chairs	44	64%
Area Standing and Special Committee Members	113	36%
District DCM/Alt-DCMs	60	65%
GSRs/Alt-GSRs	275	35%
Others (e.g., Interested AAs, Liaisons, Past Delegates, other district members)	112	39%
Total Users	622	42%

Summary: Benefits of *Share44* for NJ Area 44

- Role-based IDs and email directory for ease of use and to maintain anonymity
- Shared mailboxes and distribution lists for emails to districts, committees, and BTG
- Calendar for events with online meeting links
- Documents centrally stored and shared
- IDs used for external accounts such as Zoom and QuickBooks for continuity after rotation

Summary: *Share44* and the AA Traditions

- **Tradition 5:** Used to help NJ AA service members carry the message
- **Tradition 6:** Use NJArea44.Org domain to avoid endorsement of MS
- **Tradition 7:** Self-supporting with a free subscription for non-profits
- **Tradition 12:** Maintains anonymity without using personal identifiable data

Summary: Challenges of *Share44* for NJ Area 44

- User commitment for using and learning ***Share44***
- Significant committee effort needed for training, support, and maintenance
- Multiple service roles do not fit well with role-based IDs and role display names
